

Improve performance by using the same tools commercial vehicle inspectors use. HTEC provides instant access to both the current and voluntary regulations. A RegScan sponsored study found that inspectors using HTEC found 86% more violations, while spending 1/3 less time to perform each inspection.

Save Time and Improve Consistency – Using HazMat Trucking Enforces saves time, since it is faster than looking up loads on charts and tables. Consistency improves because questions are not skipped, data entry is done the same by all employees, and steps are not missed.

Reduce Errors on Inter-City Pickups – Each time new items are added to a load, the potential exists for new placarding or segregation errors. Eliminate these errors by providing Dispatchers access to HazMat Trucking Enforcer. Prior to adding items to a load recalculate the placarding and segregation options to uncover hidden conflicts.

Optimized for Quick Entry - All entry is based on the information required to be present on the shippers' manifest, or, is directly observable from looking at the load. The design of HazMat Trucking Enforcer strives to minimize the amount of information that must be entered. When exceptions are allowed, questions are provided requesting information to confirm eligibility for that exemption. In situations where options, such as limited quantity, are not allowed, that option is grayed out.

Modular Design – Allows you to use as much or as little of HazMat Trucking Enforcer as you need. If all you need to do is confirm proper placarding, segregation, trailer markings, and shipping paper permits, then run placarding and shipping paper auditor. If you need to perform motor cargo tank audits you can do that too.

Electronic Regulatory Reference Guide – The full-text of regulations, graphics, images and tables shown in 49 CFR (100 to 180) are provided within the HazMat Regs information module; eliminates the need to buy more books, saving you money. Hyperlinks provide quick access to the underlying regulations and make reviewing easier.

Unlike hardcopy CFR books, the electronic reference is updated with all Federal Register changes on a regular basis. Embedded citational links make it easy to toggle between regulatory cross-references. A quick-links document, found in the HazMat Regs explorer frame, provides immediate access to essential tables and illustrations. The HazMat Regs bookmark function allows you to add 30 customized links to critical citations, tables or other regulatory topics found within 49 CFR (100 – 180). (All modules must be installed on the local harddrive to make use of the bookmark function.) Ease of access to critical reference information is a hallmark of HazMat Trucking Enforcer.

Reduce training costs – HazMat Trucking Enforcer makes training and education on both current and future regulations faster and easier. Its graphical user interface is highly effective for “show-and-tell” training. The ability to flip from one rule set to another makes it easy to get staff ready for new regulatory changes.

Improve public safety and security – Using HazMat Trucking Enforcer helps improve public safety. Reduce placarding, segregation, and trailer marking errors, reduce fines, and reduce out-of-of-service rates due to placarding and segregation errors. The US DOT estimates that over 50% of all hazardous material shipments contain errors.
